UAB CONCLUDES 2023 SEASON AT NORTH TEXAS:

Following a 34-24 victory over Temple last Saturday, the UAB football team concludes the 2023 season and year one under the direction of Head Coach Trent Dilfer on Saturday at North Texas. Both UAB and UNT are 4-7 overall and both are coming off wins last week. UAB has dominated this series, winning each of the last five games and leads the all-times series 6-1 overall. The Blazers will look to earn their first road win of the season on Saturday.

BROWN JR. CONTINUES TO SET RECORDS:

Jermaine Brown Jr. has set two school records in back-to-back week and looks to keep his All-America worthy season going at North Texas. Two weeks ago, Brown became UAB's career leader in all-purpose yards and currently has 4,846 to his credit. Last week at Temple, he became the school record holder for career receptions by a running back and his 94 receptions are currently the 10th most ever at UAB. Brown Jr. is coming off a game in which he had a career-high 153 rushing yards and he needs 38 rushing yards against North Texas to become just the third player in school history to eclipse 3,000 career rushing yards (Spencer Brown and DeWayne McBride).

JACOB ZENO LOOKING TO CAP STELLAR SEASON ON SATURDAY:

Jacob Zeno, who adds to his single season school record with every pass he completes, is having one of the greatest seasons a UAB quarterback as ever had. He currently ranks second nationally in completion percentage (74.5) and fourth nationally in completions per game (26.3). Zeno is 263-of-353 for 2,841 yards, 18 touchdowns and nine interceptions. Zeno needs 340 passing yards to set the single season record for passing yards.

UAB DEFENSE HAS BIG TIME PERFORMANCE VS TEMPLE:

UAB's defense had one of its best outings of the season against Temple, holding the Owls' high-powered offense to just 24 points and 378 yards while tallying two sacks, three TFL, 10 quarterback hurries, nine pass breakups, an interception and a fumble recovery. The Blazers rank fifth nationally in fumble recoveries with 11.

PALMER CONTINUES TO SHINE AT WIDEOUT:

Tejjuan Palmer recorded his fourth 100-yard receiving game against Temple with eight catches for 125 yards and a touchdown. Palmer has 45 catches for a team-best 760 yards and six touchdowns. Palmer needs 114 receiving yards against North Texas to move into the top 10 for career receiving yards at UAB. He currently has 1,281 receiving yards.

Dilfer most recently spent the last four years as the head coach of Lipscomb Academy in Nashville where he led the Mustangs to back-to-back TSSAA D2-AA State Championship titles. Dilfer compiled an overall record of 44-10 in his four years and a mark of 26-1 in the last two seasons.

Dilfer was selected sixth overall in the 1994 NFL Draft by the Tampa Bay Buccaneers and threw for 20,518 yards and 113 touchdowns during his 14-year career. In 2000, he led the Baltimore Ravens to a 34-7 victory over the New York Giants in Super Bowl XXXV. He was named to the Pro Bowl in 1997 and was the recipient of the Bart Starr Award and Ed Block Courage Award in 2003.

"Having the opportunity to lead such a quality program like UAB is one that I am beyond excited about," Dilfer said. "The investments the university has made for UAB Football aligns with my vision of taking this program to new heights as we join the American Athletic Conference and compete annually for the highest prize of playing in the College Football Playoff. I would like to thank President Ray Watts, Director of Athletics Mark Ingram and the entire search committee for their commitment to excellence and for trusting in me as we venture into this new era of UAB Football together."

"This is an exciting day for UAB Football and the entire UAB community of students, faculty, staff, alumni and fans," said UAB President Ray Watts. "At UAB, excellence is the standard, and it is clear that Coach Dilfer will personify that standard. He is a well-networked Super Bowl champion with a national platform, and a successful coach who has helped teams and individuals – including some of the NFL's most elite quarterbacks – reach their potential.

"I thank the search committee for their dedication to this process, as well as the University of Alabama System Office and the UA System Board of Trustees for their continued support of our great institution and UAB Athletics every day," Watts said. "I also thank Bryant Vincent for serving as our interim head football coach and leading the football staff and team during a critical time in the program's history. We are proud and appreciative of their dedication."

Dilfer attended Fresno State where he was the starting quarterback and was named the WAC Offensive Player of the Year in 1993 after throwing for 3,799 yards and 30 touchdowns. Following his junior season, Dilfer declared for the NFL Draft, forgoing his senior season.

Dilfer and his wife Cassandra have three daughters, Maddie, Tori and Delaney, and a son Trevin, who passed away in 2003.

In 2008, Dilfer began a nine-year broadcasting career as an analyst on ESPN for a variety of programs, including Monday Night Countdown and NFL Primetime. He was nominated for a Sports Emmy in 2012 for Outstanding Sports Personality in the Studio Analyst category.

Dilfer also helped establish the Elite 11 Academy which began in 2009 and was launched to train elite-level high school quarterbacks. His alumni include 27 of the 32 current NFL starting quarterbacks and 14 of the past 15 Heisman Trophy winning quarterbacks. Currently, 60 of the 64 Power 5 starting quarterbacks in 2022 attended the Elite 11 Finals or Elite 11 Regional.

"Trent is a proven winner on and off the field at all levels and will be a tremendous leader for our program," Ingram said. "He is a Super Bowl-winning quarterback who played the game at its highest level for many years, and he has coached some of the top quarterbacks who are currently NFL franchise players. Trent's goals and vision for our program is to lead UAB to the College Football Playoff and we have no doubt that he is the right coach to lead our transition in the American Athletic Conference. BIRMINGHAM – Quarterback Jacob Zeno set a school record with 38 pass completions to lead the UAB football team past North Carolina A&T 35-6 on Thursday night at Protective Stadium.

Zeno was 38-of-41 overall for 291 yards and three touchdowns. He surpassed the previous record of 33 completions held by John Whitcomb set back in 1994. The three touchdown passes were also a career high.

Zeno's completion percentage of 92.7 percent was also the fourth highest completion percentage in American Athletic Conference history.

The victory was also the first for Head Coach Trent Dilfer and UAB has now won eight straight season openers.

Defensively, UAB held North Carolina A&T to just 163 yards of total offense and just 16 total passing yards. Linebacker Jackson Bratton led the charge with a career-high 12 tackles, two sacks and one forced fumble. Overall, UAB had six sacks and nine TFL.

UAB (1-0) won the toss, elected to receive, and marched straight down the field on 13 plays to score a touchdown on its first possession of the season. Jermaine Brown Jr. capped the drive with a 10-yard touchdown run to give UAB the early lead.

The Aggies converted a 37-yard field goal on their first possession, but the Blazer surged ahead with another touchdown run from Brown Jr., this time a 4-yard score, to give the Blazers a 14-3 lead at the 12:07 mark of the second quarter. For Brown, it was his 20th career rushing touchdown.

UAB was unable to score on its third possession, but the Blazers turned right back around and scored on their fourth possession with :25 second left for a commanding 21-3 halftime lead. The touchdown was an incredible throw and catch from Zeno to Tejhaun Palmer in the corner of the end zone.

Zeno was 18-of-19 in the first half for 129 yards and a touchdown.

A 34-yard touchdown pass to T.J. Jones late in the third and a 4-yard pass to Iverson "Strap" Hooks in the fourth capped the scoring for UAB as they cruised to the 29-point victory.

Zeno found 13 different receivers throughout the evening with five players sharing a game-high four catches and nine players having at least three.

The Blazers now hit the road for a Week 2 contest at Georgia Southern next Saturday, Sept. 9, in Statesboro.

STATESBORO, Ga. - The UAB football team fell to Georgia Southern 49-35 at Allen E. Paulson Stadium on Saturday night.

UAB outgained Georgia Southern 477-462 for the game, and Jacob Zeno threw for a career-high 385 yards, but Georgia Southern's balanced offensive attack proved too much for the Blazers.

Tejhaun Palmer notched his second career 100-yard game with six catches for 102 yards, while tight end Bryce Damous (7 catches, 47 yards, TD) and Iverson "Strap" Hooks (6 catches, 80 yards) each set career highs in receptions, while Hooks' 80 yards were also a new career high.

Defensively, Keondre Swoopes returned to the field after missing Week 1 and led the Blazers with nine stops. The Eagles quarterback Davis Brin through, threw for 318 yards and two touchdowns while he, OJ Arnold and Jalen White all rushed for a touchdown.

The Blazers fumbled on the first play of the game which Georgia Southern turned into seven points just four plays later on a 5-yard touchdown pass.

GASO went ahead 14-0 with 2:56 left in the opening quarter with a Davis Brin's second touchdown pass of the game, this time a 4-yard completion.

However, the Blazers responded with a 22-point second quarter to claw back into the game. Jermaine Brown Jr. got the Blazers on the board with a 19-yard touchdown run at the 14:15 mark of the second.

The Eagle surged ahead 21-7 as running back OJ Arnold tossed a 26-yard touchdown pass, but UAB scored 15-unanswered points and took its first lead of the game of the game with 1:44 left in the half.

Following a 5-yard touchdown pass from Zeno to Damous, Isaiah Jacobs scored on UAB's next possession, and the Blazers' 2-point conversion was good as Harrison Barker rushed it in for a 22-21 lead. A late 39-yard touchdown run from GASO's Arnold gave the Eagles a 28-22 halftime lead.

The two teams traded touchdowns in the third as UAB's came courtesy of an 8-yard pass from Zeno to Hooks, and the two teams went into the fourth with Georgia Southern leading 35-29.

The Eagle offense started the 4th quarter with 11 unanswered points, swelling the lead to 46-29. Zeno took in a 1-yard touchdown on a quarterback sneak to bring down the deficit to 46-35, but a failed onside kick and a late Georgia Southern field goal with 1:36 left to play put the game out of reach with a final score of 49-35.

ATHENS, Ga. – The UAB football team put forth a valiant effort but ultimately fell short at No. 1 Georgia by the score of 49-21 on Saturday night at Sanford Stadium.

UAB quarterback Jacob Zeno accounted for all three UAB touchdowns with two passing and one rushing. He finished the game 32-of-51 for 250 yards and helped UAB (1-3) compile 336 total yards of offense.

However, the Bulldogs (4-0) gained 582 yards of total offense, led by quarterback Carson Beck who was 22-of-32 for 338 yards and three touchdowns. His top target was All-American tight end Brock Bowers who finished the game with nine catches for 121 yards and two touchdowns.

UAB won the turnover battle 3-1, highlighted by running back Lee Beebe recovering two fumbles on special teams. His first recovery late in the first quarter led directly to a UAB touchdown which tied the game at 7-7.

Defensively, safety Ike Rowell led the Blazer with eight tackles, a forced fumble and a TFL. Keondre Swoopes and Damien Miller each had six tackles and Miller forced two fumbles.

Georgia scored on the game's opening possession to take an early 7-0 lead, but the UAB defense held strong and UAB eventually tied the game at 7-7 with 14:09 left in the second quarter on a 4-yard pass from Zeno to Bryce Damous.

However, the Bulldogs scored the next 21 points to surge ahead 28-7 with 1:26 remaining in the half. The Blazers responded with an excellent hurry-up drive which was capped by Amare Thomas' first career touchdown reception, making the score 28-14 at the half.

Georgia, who has not allowed a point in the third quarter this season, added two touchdowns in the quarter to gain a 42-14 lead entering the final 15 minutes.

Each team scored a touchdown in the fourth for the final score of 49-21.

NEW ORLEANS, La. – The UAB football team suffered a 35-23 loss in its American Athletic Conference opener on Saturday afternoon at Tulane.

The Blazers (1-4, 0-1 AAC) gained 434 yards of total offense, including a season-high 170 rushing yards, but Tulane had 448 yards, including 264 on the ground to lead the Green Wave (4-1, 1-0 AAC) to victory.

With UAB trailing by five with less than a minute remaining in the contest, Tulane quarterback Michael Pratt found Lawrence Keys III on 4th-and-9 for a 32-yard touchdown to ice the game.

UAB quarterback Jacob Zeno was 27-of-35 for 236 yards, and his top target was freshman Amare Thomas who finished with eight catches for 99 yards. Running back Isaiah Jacobs had career highs in carries (18), yards (95) and touchdowns (2), while Matt Quinn accounted for the rest of the scoring as he was 3-for-3 on field goals from 31, 48 and 36 yards.

Defensively, Damien Miller and Michael Moore had a team-high seven tackles, while Moore had one of UAB's four TFLs. UAB also recovered two fumbles and now has eight fumble recoveries on the season which ranks top three nationally.

Highlighted by a 35-yard end around from wide receiver Brandon Buckhalter, the Blazers took their opening drive 65 yards in 11 plays and capped it with a 31-yard field goal from Quinn.

Tulane answered with 2:50 left in the first on a 15-yard rush from Yulkeith Brown, but UAB then tallied 17-straight points in the second quarter to surge ahead 20-7.

Jacobs scored two rushing touchdowns within a three-minute span early in the quarter, and Quinn added a season-long 48-yard field goal to cap UAB's scoring run. Jacobs' second touchdown was set up Desmond Little forcing a fumble which Nikia Eason Jr. recovered in Tulane territory.

However, Tulane scored on its final possession of the first half and the opening possession of the second half to take a 21-20 lead with 13:35 left in the third. Both Tulane touchdowns were rushing scores by Makhi Hughes, who finished the game with 123 rushing yards.

The Green Wave added to its lead with 2:50 left in the third as Pratt found tight end Alex Bauman for a 14-yard touchdown in the corner of the end zone, extending Tulane's lead to 28-20.

With the Blazers trailing by eight early in the fourth, UAB drove all the way down to the Tulane 1-yard line, but Zeno fumbled on an attempted quarterback sneak which the Green Wave recovered in the end zone.

Quinn's third field goal of the game cut the Tulane lead to 28-23 with 4:52 left, but the Green Wave was able to keep possession of the ball and converted on the 4th-and-9 to secure the victory.

The Blazers return to Protective Stadium next Saturday, Oct. 7, to host USF. Kickoff is scheduled for either 2:30 or 3 p.m. and that determination will be made on Sunday.

BIRMINGHAM – Running back Jermaine Brown Jr. and quarterback Jacob Zeno each accounted for four touchdowns as the UAB football team routed South Florida 56-35 for its first AAC victory on Saturday afternoon at Protective Stadium.

Brown Jr. tallied his ninth career 100-yard rushing game and set a career high with four rushing touchdowns, highlighted by three first half scores. He finished the game with 18 carries for 116 yards. In the process, Brown passed Jordan Howard for fifth place on UAB's career rushing list (2,541) and is now tied for fifth on UAB's career rushing touchdowns list (25).

Zeno completed 19-of-25 for 353 yards and a career-high four touchdowns. It was his second 300-yard passing game of the season and he was assisted by Tejhaun Palmer who had two catches that both went for touchdowns of 61 and 58 yards. Zeno's other two touchdown passes to Brandon Buckhalter and Amare Thomas went for 75 and 49 yards, respectively.

UAB put up 608 yards of total offense in the win, which was the first time UAB has had 600 yards of offense since the 2018 season.

UAB's defense shut down the high-powered USF offense, and despite allowing 471 yards, a majority of those were given up in the fourth quarter when the game was out of reach. UAB held USF to just 300 yards through the first three quarters and stifled South Florida quarterback Byrum Brown all afternoon.

Keondre Swoopes led the defensive charge with seven tackles, and interception and a forced fumble, each of which came in the first quarter to help the Blazers build an early 21-7 lead.

The Blazers tallied three sacks, five TFL and seven pass breakups overall, while holding Brown to 24-of-43 for 260 yards. Nikia Eason Jr. had two of the team's three sacks, while Colby Dempsey had a career-high three pass breakups.

After USF's Brown rushed for a 60-yard touchdown on the first possession of the game, Buckhalter answered on UAB's first possession with a short shovel pass which he took 75 yards to tie the score. Swoopes' interception led to Palmer's 61-yard touchdown, and Brown Jr. added a 21-yard rushing touchdown to give UAB a 21-7 lead. USF's Brown scored on the last play of the quarter to make the score 21-14 after one.

UAB outscored South Florida 14-0 in the second quarter on two Jermaine Brown Jr. touchdowns to give the Blazers a 35-14 lead at the break.

The Blazers' lead would grow to 28 on two separate occasions in the third quarter, and Palmer's second touchdown of the game in the fourth gave UAB its largest lead of 35 (56-21). USF scored the final two touchdowns of the game to make the final score 56-35.

Today was UAB's seventh annual Children's Harbor game and UAB is now 6-1 when playing for Children's Harbor.

UAB is back in action next weekend with a road contest at UTSA. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. on ESPN.

SAN ANTONIO – Running back Jermaine Brown Jr. had a career-high 197 all-purpose yards, but the UAB football team fell to UTSA 41-20 on Saturday night at the Alamodome.

In the process, Brown Jr. moved into third place on UAB's career all-purpose yards list with 4,265, passing the Blazers' career leading rusher Spencer Brown.

Brown Jr. notched his first career 100-yard receiving game with six catches for 116 yards and added 12 carries for 57 yards and his eighth rushing touchdown of the season, along with 24 kickoff return yards.

Defensively, Colby Dempsey had a career night with 10 tackles, a TFL and two pass breakups.

Despite outgaining UTSA 364-360, UAB had three costly turnovers which resulted in 14 points for the Roadrunners. With the loss, UAB falls to 2-5 overall and 1-2 in the AAC. UTSA is now 3-3 and 2-0 in league play.

UTSA received the opening kick and drove 75 yards in eight plays to take an early 7-0 lead on a 19-yard rush from Robert Henry.

On UAB's first possession, the Roadrunners recovered a sack fumble at the plus 10-yard line and cashed that into seven points on the next play courtesy of a 10-yard pass from Frank Harris to Joshua Cephus for a 14-0 lead at the 10:41 mark of the opening quarter.

The Blazers settled down and took their second possession 75 yards in 11 plays and Jacob Zeno capped it with his fourth rushing touchdown of the season to make the score 14-7 with 5:21 left in the first.

UTSA then returned the ensuing kickoff 58 yards and six plays later Harris found Cephus again, this time a 4-yard strike, for a 21-7 advantage with 3:10 left in the first.

The second quarter featured three field goals, two of which came from UAB's Matt Quinn from 25 and 37 yards, respectively. His second field goal with 1:41 left in the half made the score 24-13.

UTSA drove down to the UAB 2-yard line with 19 second left, but cornerback BJ Mayes then made the play of the half by intercepting a trick play in the end zone to keep the score 24-13 in favor of UTSA at halftime. It was Mayes' second interception of the season.

Brown Jr. continued his electric play out of the halftime break, and his 25-yard rushing touchdown on UAB's first possession of the second half brought the score to 24-20 with 9:09 remaining in the third.

The Roadrunners then responded with a 10-play drive that was capped by a 1-yard rush from Kevorian Barnes, extending the UTSA lead to 31-20 with 5:54 left in the third.

A school record tying 53-yard field goal from Chase Allen at the 12:09 mark of the fourth and another 1-yard run from Barnes with 8:40 left would conclude the scoring for the UTSA victory.

UAB returns to Protective Stadium next Saturday, Oct. 21 for the renewed Battle for the Bones rivalry against Memphis. Kickoff is scheduled for 11 a.m. CT on ESPN2.

BIRMINGHAM – Memphis outscored UAB 24-0 in the second half and earned a 45-21 victory over the Blazers on Saturday afternoon at Protective Stadium.

UAB (2-6, 1-3 AAC) put up 381 yards of total offense, but only managed 49 after time. Memphis (5-2, 2-1 AAC) forced four UAB turnovers with three interceptions and a fumble recovery, and turned those turnovers into 21 points which was the deciding factor in the game.

Redshirt junior Harrison Barker made his first career start in replacement of Jacob Zeno who was out today with a concussion. Barker led a three-quarterback system as he, Trace Campbell and Landry Lyddy combined to go 15-of-28 for 173 yards, two touchdowns and three INTs.

Defensively, Michael Moore had a career-high 12 tackles, while Ike Rowell joined him in double figures with 10 to lead the UAB defense. Memphis running back Blake Watson had 21 carries for 125 yards and a touchdown and led the Tigers offense that had 193 rushing yards and 159 passing yards.

The Blazers scored on each of their first two possessions and led 14-7 after one quarter. On UAB's first possession, Barker connected on a 32-yard strike to Tejhaun Palmer and the two-point conversion was good for an 8-0 lead.

After a Memphis score, Jermaine Brown Jr. tallied his AAC-leading ninth rushing touchdown of the season, bringing the score to 14-7 after a failed 2-point conversion. Brown had 83 rushing yards for the game.

The Tigers tied the ball game with 12:55 left in the half on a 7-yard reception from Seth Henigan to Brendan Doyle, and then took the lead with 5:45 left on a 36-yard interception which Malik Feaster returned for a touchdown, giving Memphis its first lead of the game at 21-14.

A 29-yard touchdown pass from Landry Lyddy to Bryce Damous brought UAB even with 2:45 left and the two teams went into the locker room all square at 21 apiece.

However, it was all Memphis in the third quarter as they outscored UAB 17-0 to take a commanding 38-21 lead. The Tigers punched in a 2-yard rush with 2:26 left in the contest for the final points of the game.

The Blazers enter their one and only bye week of the season and then return to Protective Stadium on Nov. 4 to host Florida Atlantic. Kickoff for that game time will be released this coming Monday.

BIRMINGHAM – Quarterback Jacob Zeno set the UAB FBS school record with 484 passing yards and Matt Quinn hit a game-winning 26-yard field goal with three seconds left to lift the Blazers to a 45-42 victory over Florida Atlantic on Saturday at Protective Stadium.

Zeno finished the game 29-of-35 for 484 yards and tied the FBS school record with five touchdown passes. Zeno's five touchdown passes were to five different players, and his fifth to Tejhaun Palmer was a 70-yard strike to tie the game at 42 with 4:20 left.

On Florida Atlantic's ensuing drive, the Blazers forced a punt, giving Zeno the ball back with 1:33 left. Zeno, Jermaine Brown Jr. and Palmer engineered a game-winning drive that left Quinn a chip shot for the victory.

Brown Jr. compiled a career-high 210 all-purpose yards while Palmer had a career day catching the ball with nine catches for 179 yards. His 179 receiving yards are tied for the 15th most in school history.

UAB put up a season-best 614 yards and it was its second time going over 600 yards of total offense this season. UAB outgained FAU 614-484 for the game.

Defensively, true freshman Everett Roussaw Jr. had a career-high 10 tackles while fellow linebacker and UAB's leading tackler Michael Moore had nine.

The win improves UAB to 3-6 on the season and 2-3 in American Athletic Conference play. Florida Atlantic falls to 4-5 overall and 3-2 in the AAC.

Zeno threw four first-half touchdowns to help the Blazers build a 28-14 lead at halftime. Zeno was exceptional in the first half, going 17-of-19 for 289 yards.

His first was a 46-yard screen to Brown Jr. with 11 seconds remaining in the first quarter. FAU tied it up early in the second with LaJohntay Wester's first of four touchdowns on the game.

The Blazers would then surge ahead 21-7 on a 72-yard touchdown from Zeno to TJ Jones, then a 37-yard strike to Malachi Holt-Bennett with 7:29 left in the half.

A 27-yard rushing touchdown from FAU quarterback Michael Johnson Jr. cut UAB's lead to 21-14 with 4:04 left, but Zeno's fourth touchdown of the half to Amare Thomas with :37 left gave the Blazers a two-touchdown lead at the break.

UAB opened the second half with a defensive touchdown as Michael Moore deflected a Daniel Richardson pass which Kendall Johnson intercepted and returned 26 yards to the house for a 35-14 Blazer lead just 50 seconds into the third quarter.

However, Wester took over the game and scored three straight touchdowns on a 3-yard rush, a 20-yard pass and a 76-yard pass to tie the game at 35-35 with 14:42 left in the fourth. Wester, who leads the nation in catches per game, had 11 receptions for 219 yards.

UAB's defense made plays down the stretch when it mattered, and a pass breakup from BJ Mayes on third down gave the ball back to UAB with just under five minutes to go, which is when Zeno found Palmer on the 70-yard strike to tie the game.

On FAU's next possession, Roussaw made his 10th tackle on an FAU 3rd-and-8, forcing the Owls to punt on 4th-and-2.

Brown started UAB's final drive with back-to-back plays totaling 30 yards and he had 34 total yards on that drive, while Palmer had two catches for 32 yards on the drive.

The Blazers now head to Navy for a contest with the Midshipmen next Saturday, Nov. 11, on Veterans Day. Kickoff is scheduled for 2:30 p.m. CT on CBS Sports Network

ANNAPOLIS, Md. – Navy outscored the UAB football team 21-0 in the fourth quarter which propelled the Midshipmen to a 31-6 victory on Saturday at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium.

With Navy leading 10-6 midway through the third quarter, the Midshipmen used a 20-play, 80-yard drive which took up over 12 minutes on the clock for a 17-6 lead, then added a 50-yard rush and a 97-yard interception return for the 31-6 victory.

The loss drops UAB to 3-7 on the season and 2-4 in the AAC. Navy is now 4-5 overall and 3-3 in league play.

Navy outgained UAB 363-321 and had 269 rushing yards, but despite those number, UAB's defense kept the Blazers in the game. Keondre Swoopes made a huge impact with five tackles, two forced fumbles, one fumble recovery and an interception. Jackson Bratton led the unit with a season-high tying 11 tackles.

BIRMINGHAM – A career-high 153 rushing yards from Jermaine Brown Jr. and a very balanced Blazer attack led the UAB football team to a 34-24 victory over Temple on Senior Day at Protective Stadium Saturday afternoon.

Brown's 153 yards came on 20 carries (7.6 YPC) and he paced the offense which had 259 rushing yards and 246 passing yards. Brown also had five receptions today and became the new school record holder for career receptions by a running and now has 94 career catches. Additionally, he moved into third place on UAB's career rushing list (2,962).

UAB (4-7, 3-4 AAC) had 505 total yards of offense and surpassed 500 yards for a third time this season. Jacob Zeno was 20-of-28 for 246 yards and a touchdown, which went to Tejhaun Palmer who notched his fourth 100-yard receiving game of the season with eight catches for 125 yards.

Redshirt freshman running back Lee Beebe added a career high 70 rushing yards and a touchdown on 10 carries.

Defensively, UAB held a high-powered Temple offense to 378 yards and just 122 yards in the second half. The Blazers applied pressure in the backfield the entire night which resulted in two sacks, three TFL, 10 quarterback hurries, nine pass breakups and a fumble recovery. Seven different players had a pass breakup, led by freshman linebacker Everett Roussaw Jr., while Jackson Bratton and Nikia Eason Jr. each had three QBH.

Temple (3-8, 1-6 AAC) took an early 7-0 lead on a 71-yard touchdown pass from E.J. Warner to Dante Wright with 11:33 left in the first.

It took the Blazers until 4:22 left in the first half to find the end zone, and Beebe's second touchdown of the season evened the game at 7-7.

Temple scored on its next possession as Warner found David Martin-Robinson on a 47-yard connection. A 29-yard field goal from UAB's Matt Quinn as the first half expired made the score 14-10 at the half.

UAB outscored Temple 24-10 in the second half but the game was back-and-forth until the final two minutes when UAB surged ahead by 10.

UAB took a 17-14 lead with 5:19 left in the third as senior Demetrius Battle scored his first touchdown as a Blazer on a 3-yard rush. The Owls then tied the game on a 40-yard field at the 2:03 mark of the third.

Palmer gave UAB a 24-17 lead with 14:24 left on a spectacular 22-yard catch for his sixth receiving touchdown of the season. However, Temple once again tied it up in a 1-yard rush from Martin-Robinson for his second touchdown of the game.

On UAB's ensuing drive, the Blazers put together a 12-play 66-yard drive which took 6:26 off the clock and gave the Blazers a 27-24 advantage after a 26-yard field goal from Quinn.

A defensive stop gave the ball back to the Blazers and Brown Jr. capped an 8-play drive with a 2-yard rushing touchdown for a 34-24 lead which would be the final points of the game.

The Blazers controlled the second half clock and almost doubled up Temple on time of possession (19:21-10:39) in the final half.

UAB finished the 2023 home season with a record of 4-2 and is now 12-5 at Protective Stadium and 33-6 in Birmingham since returning to action in 2017.
